PROGRAMME

The five-day Conference programme will include:

- Plenary reports describing state-of-the-art of bioenergy technologies and prospects of their development;
- Oral and poster presentations on specific research, development, demonstration and commercial projects;
- Technical tours and cultural programme.

TOPICS

- 1. Biomass resources:** production, pre-treatment, supply and logistics for biomass feedstock from forestry, agriculture, animal breeding and processing industries.
- 2. Research and development of bioenergy technologies:** combustion, gasification, pyrolysis, biological conversion (biogas, landfill gas) and liquid fuels production (biodiesel, ethanol, liquefaction).
- 3. Demonstration and commercial implementation of biomass-to-energy technologies in the heat and electricity sectors.**
- 4. Demonstration and commercial implementation of liquid and gaseous fuels production and utilisation from biomass.**
- 5. Strategy and policy issues:** challenges and opportunities to support the EU Policies and Directives, the Kyoto Protocol, certificates, national and local regulations, globalisation and liberalisation, industry policies, security of energy supply.
- 6. Feasibility study of bioenergy technologies, their social and environmental impact.**

PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE

The Conference is aimed at encouragement of the use of biomass for energy production and promotion of sustainable development of bioenergy technologies in Ukraine.

WORKING LANGUAGES OF THE CONFERENCE

Ukrainian, Russian, English.

Simultaneous translation of presentations will be provided.

HOW TO PREPARE AN ABSTRACT

The Organising Committee plans to publish Book of Abstracts in two languages: Russian and English. Authors wishing to submit an abstract should read the following instructions carefully and send an abstract both by mail and e-mail to the address given below. The abstract, single spaced in English, 11 size Times New Roman font, should include:

- Applicable subject number (1 to 6 above)
- Full title
- Full name and address of one author for all correspondence
- Full name of each author and co-author, affiliation, address, phone/fax/e-mail
- Purpose of the work
- Approach
- Scientific innovation and relevance
- Results
- Conclusions

The deadline for submitting abstracts to the Conference is April 30, 2002.

Abstracts should be prepared in English (obligatory) and in Russian (if possible).

The abstract should not exceed one page of format A4 (210x297). In addition, authors may add up to 3 explanatory pages, which will facilitate the reviewers assessment. Abstract with insufficient information will be rejected. All authors of accepted abstracts will receive special instruction for the preparation of the final papers for the Conference Proceedings.

PLACE OF HOLDING THE CONFERENCE

1st International Ukrainian Conference on Biomass for Energy will be held at the Science House of the National Academy of Sciences. Science House is situated in the city centre beside the well-known historical monument of Kyiv - the Golden Gates. The place of holding the Conference will give its participants a good opportunity to combine constructive work with exploring the cultural and historical treasures of Kiev - town with more than 1500 years history.
